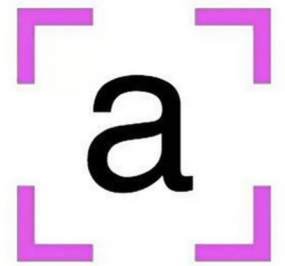


# Summer Reading List for Minneapolis 2026
